## HEALTHY BYTES

### Be Kind to Yourself

What would you do if someone said any of the following to you?

"You're just so disgusting!" "You look like a pig!" "It must be terrible to look like you do!" "You had better lose 25 pounds or else!"

It probably wouldn't go over to well. But many of us are willing to say these very same things to ourselves. We seem to think that by being hard on ourselves we will somehow become motivated to do better.

The truth is just the opposite. When a person doesn't feel good about themselves and sees themselves as undeserving and unworthy, they set themselves up to fail at their weight loss efforts.

To counteract negative thinking learn to give yourself credit for everything you do right. Say things like: Great! • Good job! • I did it! • Way to go! • I can do this! • Keep up the good work!

Judith Beck, in her book, *The Beck Diet Solution*, suggests the following activities to help you recognize your positive behaviors: Write down the word "credit" on a sticky note and put it where you'll often see it. Once or twice a day take out a notebook and write down all the things you deserve credit for. Every time you check off an item on your daily to-do list, say something positive to yourself. Buy a small counter and click it every time you deserve credit.

And when you do fail don't say, "I'm such a failure." Instead, say something like, "I didn't do as well as I'd like but will do better next time."

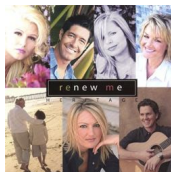

**THE LAST WORD****Romans 8: 28-39** (21st Century KJV)

<sup>28</sup> We know that in all things God works for good with those who love Him, those whom He has called according to His purpose. <sup>29</sup> Those whom God had already chosen He also set apart to become like His Son, so that the Son would be the first among many believers. <sup>30</sup> And so those whom God set apart, He called; and those He called, He put right with Himself, and He shared His glory with them.

<sup>31</sup> In view of all this, what can we say? If God is for us, who can be against us? <sup>32</sup> Certainly not God, who did not even keep back His own Son, but offered Him for us all! He gave us His Son—will He not also freely give us all things? <sup>33</sup> Who will accuse God's chosen people? God Himself declares them not guilty! <sup>34</sup> Who, then, will condemn them? Not Christ Jesus, Who died, or rather, Who was raised to life and is at the right side of God, pleading with Him for us! <sup>35</sup> Who, then, can separate us from the love of Christ? Can trouble do it, or hardship or persecution or hunger or poverty or danger or death? <sup>36</sup> As the scripture says,

For your sake we are in danger of death at all times;  
we are treated like sheep that are going to be slaughtered.

<sup>37</sup> No, in all these things we have complete victory through Him Who loved us! <sup>38</sup> **For I am certain that nothing can separate us from His love: neither death nor life, neither angels nor other heavenly rulers or powers, neither the present nor the future, <sup>39</sup> neither the world above nor the world below—there is nothing in all creation that will ever be able to separate us from the love of God which is ours through Christ Jesus our Lord.**
