On May 9, Printess Schlist received the distinguished honor of being chosen by the Greater Madera Kiwanis Club and Madera Community Hospital to be the recipient of the "Greater Madera Kiwanis Club and Madera Community Hospital 2012 Registered Nurse of the Year Award." She was chosen from nine nurses in recognition of her dedication and service. She was nominated by a charge nurse in outpatient surgery for her role as grief counselor in outpatient surgery, where she supports patients who have lost a baby either at birth or during pregnancy. The Kiwanis Club reviews all recommendations and gives the award to whom they believe is most qualified. Printess will represent the Central Valley Region next year as its representative for the statewide award.

Printess is an RN clinical coordinator on the obstetrics floor at the Madera Community Hospital, a lactation educator and the RTS (Restore Through Sharing) Bereavement Coordinator supporting parents and families through the loss of a baby.

HEALTHY BYTES



Rest

The best hours of “repair” of the body are while we sleep between 9pm and 2am: POWER SLEEP; and of those the hours before midnight are the best. We have a “growth hormone” that repairs the cells and organs of the body each night while we sleep. But there is one thing that can block this repair: insulin. Insulin is present whenever we eat, and it stays until our food is digested. So, “if insulin is there, growth hormone cannot repair”. What about that late night snack before bedtime? You just sabotaged yourself! We wonder why we wake up so tired; it is because no “repair work” happened while we slept. All the damage that was done to our cells and organs the day before stays with us throughout the day. Imagine repeating this night after night.

If you are “starving” and need something late, make it a piece of fruit, just enough to stave off the hunger. Fruit digests quickly so hopefully, repair work can still be done. Remember: “If insulin is there, growth hormone cannot repair!”
