Cayenne Pepper



Cayenne pepper is probably in your spice cabinet. This spice is a great food for the circulatory system, which helps every area of the body. CHURCH FINANCE 101 - "RENT VS. OWN"

(Second in Series)

It's a question that comes up frequently when considering a home. In this case it is a church home, and the question is, "Is it better to rent or to own?" Below is a brief analysis of our costs for a physical place to worship, comparing what it was at Hope Lutheran (rent) to what it is now to own our facility here on Maroa Ave.
